



## pre-contribution submission guidelines

---

*The pre-contribution submission is the first step of the publishing process. This pre-contribution will be reviewed internally. We will get back to you to inform you of whether your project has been accepted and with information about the next steps of the publishing process.*

### **information to provide:**

- title *(with subtitle, when necessary)*
- authors / project team *(with affiliated institutions / framework, and ORCID if applicable)*
- a main contact for the contribution
- authors of the pre-contribution submission *(with affiliated institutions / framework, if applicable and if different from those previously mentioned)*
- a few pictures with captions and credits *(to account for the general aesthetics of your contribution)*
- a short text presenting the project with a clear research focus, its multidisciplinary methodology *(3,000 characters maximum)*
- explanation / description of your visual approach to publishing *(what you want to do visually, how and why)*
- a list of keywords *(around 10)*
- a preselected *.able* layout: *scroll.able*, *pan.able*, *zoom.able*, *story.able*, *video.able*
- a bibliography *(using Chicago 17th Manual of Styles format)*
- illustrations information or all relevant info regarding the images or media content you intend to use *(rights owners, context of production...)*
- you can add useful resources, files or appendix if it is needed
